Budget Update

Last week, Governor Beshear notified some state agencies to submit a plan for 6 percent cuts to their current budgets. We are pleased to inform you that at this time, there is no intention to cut adult education funding.

Robert L. King, president of the Council on Postsecondary Education stated, “The good news from the prospective of higher ed is there is no intention to reduce funding to the universities or to KCTCS (Kentucky Community and Technical College System). And they have indicated an intention not to cut funding to adult education.”

If this information is entered incorrectly, staff may encounter issues registering for courses in PDtrack and accessing their online courses in ANGEL.
2. Also, please confirm that the “Manage Your Locations” information is up-to-date. Double-check spelling and capitalization of your entries as this information is an automatic upload to the [KYAE Local County Contacts](#). This information is what potential students first see on KYAE’s Web site when contacting a local center. Be sure to only use the actual physical address and not a mailing address.
