
Resource for instructors! KYAE's new home on HippoCampus

Great news! KYAE now has its own customized HippoCampus site! Any KYAE instructor will now have access to his/her own teacher's page, which allows the user to customize instruction for his/her students. Those of you who have used the HippoCampus open site, will love the new features available through KYAE's new customized site. If you've not yet discovered HippoCampus, you'll soon realize what great instructional materials live there. Just a few simple steps and you'll be set:

1. Go to <http://www.hippocampus.org/?user=myKYAE> to create your teacher's account.
2. Once you have an account, you'll be able to create playlists with videos from any of the HippoCampus collections or even upload material from other Internet sites.
3. The [How to Make a Playlist on HippoCampus](#) video walks you through the steps:


Click on any subject under Browse Subjects.



Then scroll to the bottom of the page. You will see the video there.
