

# INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMBINING OUT-OF-STATE GED® RECORDS

GED Testing Service has developed a process to help get **non-passing GED Test scores from another state** for those wanting to complete the GED Tests in Kentucky. Now test-takers will no longer have to provide an official transcript with the non-passing scores from another state. Contact your local testing center so the student can sign the release form required by GED Testing Service. Give the signed release back to the GED Examiner at the testing center. It will only take a few days to get the scores. Please remember, out-of-state scores cannot be imported into the Kentucky record until the GED123 record is created. This process is only available for those with non-passing scores earned in another state after 1/1/2002.
