


# KENTUCKY Adult Education


KYAE is pleased to announce that the Worldwide Interactive Network (WIN) suite of career readiness products is ready for use by students. Thanks to the diligence of our technical support team, **WIN is now available through single sign-on (SSO) in KAERS**. This means that instructors and students alike will not have to keep track of different credentials and will be able to enter WIN directly through the KAERS portal.

As in the past, instructors will check the WIN goal in KAERS, which will automatically create the access point for entry in WIN. The WIN goal can be checked by going to **the Enrollment tab** and selecting WIN CCR from the drop down.

Once the goal is checked in KAERS, students will see the button to click to enter WIN. It's that simple!

**IMPORTANT REMINDER:** The resources provide information for enrolling students and changing passwords. Since Kentucky is the first state to fully integrate and provide single sign-on (SSO) with a student management system (KAERS), this does not apply to our WIN portal.

**Please do not change passwords as that will affect student access.**

Students now have the means to earn a Kentucky Essential Skills Certificate (KESC) by completing courseware and assessments to validate that they recognize the essential skills needed to get a job, keep a job and advance in the workplace.. The WIN soft skills courseware includes four modules for which students can earn electronic badges (E Badges). Once all four E Badges are earned, students can print the KESC as one of the stackable credentials certifying them as being prepared for improved employment opportunities in their local communities.



The WIN Soft Skills course is a great start for student understanding of the importance for workplace skills, but classroom instruction and interaction are key to the application of soft skills to the real world. Another tool available to you with the launch of WIN is a collection of instructional units that teach the WIN soft skills course and its offline resources. These units align with the CCRS and the KYAE Employability Standards in student-centered lessons designed to help you incorporate contextualized instruction into your classes. The units incorporate the WIN soft skills online course modules and offline resources, along with additional resources and activities, and are ready for your use. Additional lessons are being developed for the KYAE Lesson Bank that aligns both the standards and the WIN soft skills materials. Every lesson in the bank integrates the KYAE Employability Standards with academic content, so check back often to see what is new!
