## **ANNOUNCING: Upcoming EdReady Pilots**

### **Announcing: KYAE 6-Week EdReady Pilot Scheduled for February/March 2017**

Montana has piloted and implemented EdReady in adult education programs throughout their state with impressive results. KYAE needs data to determine whether Kentucky might see similar results.

EdReady is a distance learning math curriculum that is online, video-based, and fully customizable. **The curriculum is entirely free for to all KYAE programs with unlimited usage and student seats.** KCTCS has adopted EdReady as both an admissions test and remediation pathway.

#### **In the spring, KYAE will initiate three EdReady pilots:**

1. As supplemental instruction for the 20 counties participating in the EMPower Plus pilot
2. As a tool for both distance learning and the flipped classroom model for students in Jefferson County
3. **As a distance learning and/or computer lab math curriculum for all other interested KYAE programs**

Rudy Rhoades and Gayle Box will oversee the pilots. Participants will receive EdReady training and assistance. **No travel will be required.**
