As you may be aware, DRC has been receiving feedback from our TABE® customers that it was taking students much less time than the stated “maximum allowable time” to complete the TABE 11&12 subtests. We have also been closely monitoring operational testing times. As a result, DRC submitted a request to the U.S. Department of Education to make changes to the maximum allowable time for a student to complete each TABE 11&12 subtest.

We are happy to announce that the U.S. Department of Education has approved our request to shorten the maximum allowable times across content areas. The revised times are reflected in the table below.

Level	Reading Total Time	Language Total Time	Math Total time
E,M,D,A	120 minutes	60 Minutes	75 minutes
